Chief Technician - Lighting JOB DESCRIPTION

DEPARTMENT: Production RESPONSIBLE TO: Head of Production

THE KEY OBJECTIVES OF THIS POST ARE:

- to be responsible for the delivery of all technical equipment and production lighting requirements for performances and events throughout Anvil Arts venues
- to be committed, to the highest standards of technical production presentation and service with the aim of delivering a customer experience that delights and is above expectation
- to act as a primary point of contact for the visiting company and house crew on a day to day basis and in the absence of the Head of Production

JOB DESCRIPTION - GENERAL

- to ensure the safety, security and wellbeing of all artists, performers, crew contractors and visitors to the back stage and production areas
- to undertake the role of Stage Manager and work alongside the production team when and where needed to include format changes
- to work closely in the planning of events with the Head of Production, Technical Manager and Administrator
- to maintain technical training and knowledge relevant to the post, bringing any identified personal training requirements to the attention of the Head of Production
- such other duties as necessary, that are compatible with the nature of the post

JOB DESCRIPTION - SPECIFIC

Performances, exhibitions, hires and events

- to be proficient in the provision of technical services for all performances, exhibitions, hires and events with special attention to all lighting requirements
- to reference and implement technical production requirements as detailed on Artifax and visiting company technical plans and riders
- to supervise and assist in the installation rigging and lifting of PA and lighting equipment
- to liaise with and always monitor visiting company technicians and hirers/ users to ensure safe operation and careful use of equipment ensuring excellent production presentation
- to conduct visiting company safety talks, evacuation drills and public on-stage risk assessments in conjunction with the Front of House department
- to ensure compliance with terms and conditions of licences granted by the local authority
- to communicate any concerns, complaints or feedback to the Head of Production and Senior Management Team



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Maintenance

- to manage the installation, cleanliness and maintenance of both Anvil Arts and hired in production equipment
- to undertake production department maintenance of performance spaces, their allied areas, and systems in conjunction with external contractors
- to undertake/ oversee maintenance of all production lighting / audio-visual equipment
- to maintain and PAT test all production lighting and electrical equipment across Anvil Arts venues
- to assist with the maintenance of all stage and production equipment
- in conjunction with Head of Production establish purchase and replacement needs for specific lighting stock

Health and Safety

- to carry out risk assessments
- to ensure compliance with relevant health and safety legislation, always working to identified control measures, safe working practices and procedures identified in risk assessments
- to monitor on- stage and backstage areas to ensure evacuation routes are kept clear
- to carry out and comply with the daily pre- show and fire safety checks according to current procedures in line with the venue's emergency evacuation plan
- to oversee the evacuation of the backstage areas in the event of an emergency
- to ensure the safety and best presentation of all backstage and production areas
- to maintain training in First Aid
- to maintain training in relevant health and safety legislation e.g. Working at Height, LOLER, Noise at work, COSHH,
- to raise service requests, or report any areas of the production department or the venue requiring service, repair or maintenance

Management of Department and staff

- to assist in the management and supervision of house production technicians and casual staff
- to ensure that the production team adhere to Anvil Arts policies and procedures
- to assist in the development, implementation and monitoring of safe working practices
- to ensure contra charges are bought to the attention of the Finance department
